REGULATIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for Club Championship points, an individual must be a fully paid up member of the Aberdare Motor Club (AMC)

2. QUALIFYING EVENTS

All Motorsport events attended by a club member will qualify for points

4. CHAMPIONSHIP TERM

The Championships will run annually from 1st January to 31st December.

5. CLAIMING POINTS

For all events, members must submit their results via the electronic form that can be found on the Aberdare Motor Club website within 14 days of the event

The Championship Coordinator reserves the right to request proof of results from members. Wherever possible the Championship Coordinator will aim to provide interim results updates periodically during the championship term. Interim results shall remain provisional at all times. Final results shall be published no later than the 12th January 2027.

6. SCORING

Points scoring will be as follows:

If more than 1 of the above roles is undertaken during a single event, the highest scoring role counts towards the championship. ***For Example a Safety Marshal who was also Passage Control Official on the same event would score 20 Points***

Points can NOT be scored on events as an official if you are paid to be there, this is a Voluntary Championship

7. CLUBMAN CHALLENGE

The Clubman Challenge will be the best 4 scores taken from any competitor who competes on 6 (or less) Interclub status (on lower) events.
